Lev 23:26

And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying,

Lev 23:27

Also on the tenth *day* of this seventh month *there shall be* a day of atonement: it shall be an holy convocation unto you; and ye shall afflict your souls, and offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD.

Est 4:16

Go, gather together all the Jews that are present in Shushan, and fast ye for me, and neither eat nor drink three days, night or day: I also and my maidens will fast likewise; and so will I go in unto the king, which *is not according to the law*: and if I perish, I perish.


Act 27:9

Lev 16:29

And *this* shall be a statute for ever unto you: *that* in the seventh month, on the tenth *day* of the month, ye shall afflict your souls, and do no work at all, *whether it be* one of your own country, or a stranger that sojourneth among you:

Lev 16:30

For on that day shall *the priest* make an atonement for you, to cleanse you, *that ye may* be clean from all your sins before the LORD.

Lev 16:31

It *shall be* a sabbath of rest unto you, and ye shall afflict your souls, by a statute for ever.

Lev 23:29

For whatsoever soul *it be* that shall not be afflicted in that same day, he shall be cut off from among his people.


Apocalypse of Paul 17

And I heard AHAYAH Alahayim, the just judge, again saying: "Come, angel of this soul, and stand in the midst." And the angel of the sinful soul came, having in his hands a manuscript, and said: "These, Ahayah, in my hands, are all the sins of this soul from his youth till to-day, from the tenth year of his birth: and if thou command, Ahayah, I will also relate his acts from the beginning of his fifteenth year."

Jubilee 34:17

17. And he mourned for Joseph one year, and did not cease, for he said "Let me go down to the grave mourning for my son." 18. For this reason it is ordained for the children of Israel that they should afflict themselves on the tenth of the seventh month--on the day that the news which made him weep for Joseph came to Jacob his father--that they should make atonement for themselves thereon with a young goat on the tenth of the seventh month, once a year, for their sins; for they had grieved the affection of their father regarding Joseph his son. 19. And this day hath been ordained that they should grieve thereon for their sins, and for all their transgressions and for all their errors, so that they might cleanse themselves on that day once a year.

Pro 28:13



He that covereth his sins shall not prosper: but whoso confesseth and forsaketh *them* shall have mercy.

It *shall be* unto you a sabbath of rest, and ye shall afflict your souls: in the ninth *day* of the month at even, from even unto even, shall ye celebrate your sabbath.

12. And the sons of Jacob slaughtered a kid, and dipped the coat of Joseph in the blood, and sent (it) to Jacob their father on the tenth of the seventh month. 13. And ye shall do no work in that same day: for it *is* a day of atonement, to make an atonement for you before the LORD your Alahayim

And whatsoever soul *it be* that doeth any work in that same day, the same soul will I destroy from among his people.

Lev 23:31

Ye shall do no manner of work: *it shall be* a statute for ever throughout your generations in all your dwellings.

Sir 51:8

Chapter Fourteen

1.And it came to pass on the first day of the seventh month, in the head of the year, in the four hundred and seventy eighth year after the children of Israel were come out of the land of Egypt, in the second year of Solomon's reign over Israel, AHAYAH's vision came unto me, and I was upon the Gihon.


2.And I raised my eyes and lo, the heavens were open like a book, and I saw the glory of AHAYAH, sitting on a lofty and exceedingly high throne. 3.And this is the appearance of the throne: twelve stairs led up to the throne (six of gold and six of silver), and there was a square back to the throne, like a sapphire stone.

4.And at its right side were three stools and at its left side were four stools near the sitting place, like the seven that see the king's face, covered with gold and silver and precious stones.

5.And the appearance of the glory of AHAYAH was like the appearance of the rainbow, His covenant.

6.And the host of heaven were standing before Him on His right hand and on His left, and Satan was standing by them, but behind them.

7.And lo, a man dressed in linen brought before the glory of AHAYAH three books that were written about every man.



8. And he read in the first one and it was found to have the just deeds of His people, and AHAYAH said: "These will live for ever."

9. And Satan said: "Who are these guilty people?" And the man dressed in linen cried to Satan like a ram's horn, saying "Keep silent, for this day is holy to our master."

10. And he read in the second book, and it was found to have inadvertent sins of His people, and AHAYAH said: "Put aside this book, but save it, until one third of the month elapses, to see what they will do."
