Feast of Trumpets

The Feast is a commemoration of Yashe coming down on Mount Sinai as Captain of Ahayah's host, with the Angels blowing trumpets as he came down. It is also a testimony of the Trumpet that will be blown and the dead shall rise from their graves.

Exo 19:15 And he said unto the people, Be ready against the third day: come not at your wives.

Exo 19:16 And it came to pass on the third day in the morning, that there were thunders and lightnings, and a thick cloud upon the mount, and the voice of the trumpet exceeding loud; so that all the people that *was* in the camp trembled.

Deu 33:2 And he said, AHAYAH came from Sinai, and rose up from Seir unto them; he shined forth from mount Paran, and he came with ten thousands of saints: from his right hand *went* a fiery law for them.

Psa 68:17 The chariots of Alahayim *are* twenty thousand, *even* thousands of angels: Adono *is* among them, *as in* Sinai, in the holy *place.*

The angels have built in Horns for praise and worship

Eze 28:13 Thou hast been in Eden the garden of Alahayim; every precious stone *was* thy covering, the sardius, topaz, and the diamond, the beryl, the onyx, and the jasper, the sapphire, the emerald, and the carbuncle, and gold: the workmanship of thy tabrets and <u>of thy pipes was prepared in thee</u> in the day that thou wast created.

Exo 19:17 And Moses brought forth the people out of the camp to meet with Alahayim; and they stood at the nether part of the mount.

Exo 19:18 And mount Sinai was altogether on a smoke, because AHAYAH descended upon it in fire: and the smoke thereof ascended as the smoke of a furnace, and the whole mount quaked greatly.

The Dead will rise at the blow of the Trumpet

1Co 15:51 Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed,

1Co 15:52 In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.

1Co 15:53 For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality.

1Co 15:54 So when this corruptible shall have put on incorruption, and this mortal shall have put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, Death is swallowed up in victory.

The Feast is on the First Day of the 7th Month

Lev 23:23 And AHAYAH spake unto Moses, saying,

Lev 23:24 Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, In the seventh month, in the first *day* of the month, shall ye have a sabbath, a memorial of blowing of trumpets, an holy convocation.

Lev 23:25 Ye shall do no servile work therein: but ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto AHAYAH.

The Feast is a time of Festivities

- Psa 81:1 To the chief Musician upon Gittith, *A Psalm* of Asaph. Sing aloud unto Alahayim our strength: make a joyful noise unto the Alahayim of Jacob.
- Psa 81:2 Take a psalm, and bring hither the timbrel, the pleasant harp with the psaltery.
- Psa 81:3 Blow up the trumpet in the new moon, in the time appointed, on our solemn feast day.
- Psa 81:4 For this was a statute for Israel, and a law of the Alahayim of Jacob.

The Feast continued to be kept even in the Midst of Tribulation

- Ezr 3:1 And when the seventh month was come, and the children of Israel *were* in the cities, the people gathered themselves together as one man to Jerusalem.
- Ezr 3:2 Then stood up Jeshua the son of Jozadak, and his brethren the priests, and Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, and his brethren, and builded the altar of the Alahayim of Israel, to offer burnt offerings thereon, as *it is* written in the law of Moses the man of Alahayim.
- Ezr 3:3 And they set the altar upon his bases; for fear *was* upon them because of the people of those countries: and they offered burnt offerings thereon unto AHAYAH, *even* burnt offerings morning and evening.
- Ezr 3:4 They kept also the feast of tabernacles, as *it is* written, and *offered* the daily burnt offerings by number, according to the custom, as the duty of every day required;
- Ezr 3:5 And afterward offered the continual burnt offering, both of the new moons, and of all the set feasts of AHAYAH that were consecrated, and of every one that willingly offered a freewill offering unto AHAYAH.
- Ezr 3:6 From the first day of the seventh month began they to offer burnt offerings unto AHAYAH. But the foundation of the temple of AHAYAH was not *yet* laid.
