

Signs to Identify the Scattered Israelites

Pt. 1: The Split of the Tribes

Deu 28:64

And Ahayah shall scatter thee among all people, from the one end of the earth even unto the other; and there thou shalt serve other alahayims, which neither thou nor thy fathers have known, *even* wood and stone.

Jer 24:9

And I will deliver them to be removed into all the kingdoms of the earth for *their* hurt, *to be* a reproach and a proverb, a taunt and a curse, in all places whither I shall drive them.

Deu 32:26

I said, I would scatter them into corners, I would make the remembrance of them to cease from among men:

Zec 1:15

And I am very sore displeased with the heathen *that are* at ease: for I was but a little displeased, and they helped forward the affliction.

Psa 83:2

For, lo, thine enemies make a tumult: and they that hate thee have lifted up the head. Psa 83:3

They have taken crafty counsel against thy people, and consulted against thy hidden ones.

Psa 83:4

They have said, Come, and let us cut them off from *being* a nation; that the name of Israel may be no more in remembrance.

Deu 28:37

And thou shalt become an astonishment, a proverb, and a byword, among all nations whither Ahayah shall lead thee

Jdt 14:13

So they came to Holofernes' tent, and said to him that had the charge of all his things, Waken now our lord: for the slaves have been bold to come down against us to battle, that they may be utterly destroyed.

Jdt 14:18

These slaves have dealt treacherously; one woman of the Hebrews hath brought shame upon the house of king Nabuchodonosor: for, behold, Holofernes lieth upon the ground without a head.

1Ma 3:39

And he gathered all Judah and Benjamin, and the strangers with them out of Ephraim



and Manasseh, and out of Simeon: for they fell to him out of Israel in abundance, when they saw that Ahayah his Alahayim *was* with him.

2Ch 15:10

So they gathered themselves together at Jerusalem in the third month, in the fifteenth year of the reign of Asa.

Testament of Simeon 5:4-6

4 For I have seen it inscribed in the writing of Enoch that your sons shall be corrupted in fornication, 5 and shall do harm to the sons of Levi with the sword. But they shall not be able to withstand Levi; 6 for he shall wage the war of AHAYAH, and shall conquer all your hosts. And they shall be few in number, divided in Levi and Judah, and there shall be none of you for sovereignty, even as also our father prophesied in his blessings.

But the word of Alahayim came unto Shemaiah the man of Alahayim, saying,

1Ki 12:23

Speak unto Rehoboam, the son of Solomon, king of Judah, and unto all the house of Judah and Benjamin, and to the remnant of the people, saying,

1Ki 12:31

And he made an house of high places, and made priests of the lowest of the people, which were not of the sons of Levi.

2Ch 11:14

For the Levites left their suburbs and their possession, and came to Judah and Jerusalem: for Jeroboam and his sons had cast them off from executing the priest's office unto Ahayah:



2Ch 11:15

And he ordained him priests for the high places, and for the devils, and for the calves which he had made.

Who in the time of Enemessar king of the Assyrians was led captive out of Thisbe, which is at the right hand of that city, which is called properly Nephthali in Galilee above Aser.

Tob 1:3

I Tobit have walked all the days of my life in the ways of truth and justice, and I did many almsdeeds to my brethren, and my nation, who came with me to Nineve, into the land of the Assyrians.

Tob 1:14

And I went into Media, and left in trust with Gabael, the brother of Gabrias, at Rages a city of Media ten talents of silver.

Tob 3:7

It came to pass the same day, that in Ecbatane a city of Media Sara the daughter of Raguel was also reproached by her father's maids; .

Tob 14:12

And when Anna his mother was dead, he buried her with his father. But Tobias departed with his wife and children to Ecbatane to Raguel his father in law,

Tob 14:13

Where he became old with honour, and he buried his father and mother in law honourably, and he inherited their substance, and his father Tobit's.

Tob 14:14 And he died at Ecbatane in Media, being an hundred and seven and twenty years old.

2 Baruch 77:17-22



17 Nevertheless, as you said unto me, I will write also unto your brethren in Babylon, and I will send by means of men, and I will write in like manner to the nine tribes and a half, and send by means of a bird.'

18 And it came to pass on the one and twentieth day in the eighth month that I, Baruch, came and sat down under the oak under the shadow of the branches, and no man was with me, but I was alone.

19 And I wrote these two epistles: one I sent by an eagle to the nine and a half tribes; and the other I sent to those that were at Babylon by means of three men.

20 And I called the eagle and spoke these words unto it:

21 'The Most High hath made you that you should be higher than all birds.

22 And now go and tarry not in (any) place, nor enter a nest, nor settle upon any tree, till you have passed over the breadth of the many waters of the river Euphrates, and have gone to the people that dwell there, and cast down to them this epistle.

78 1 These are the words of that epistle which Baruch the son of Neriah sent to the nine and a half tribes, which were across the river Euphrates, in which these things were written.

2Es 13:40

Those are the ten tribes, which were carried away prisoners out of their own land in the time of Osea the king, whom Salmanasar the king of Assyria led away captive, and he carried them over the waters, and so came they into another land.

2Es 13:41

But they took this counsel among themselves, that they would leave the multitude of the heathen, and go forth into a further country, where never mankind dwelt,

2Es 13:42

That they might there keep their statutes, which they never kept in their own land.

2Es 13:43

And they entered into Euphrates by the narrow places of the river.

2Es 13:44

For the most High then shewed signs for them, and held still the flood, till they were passed over.

2Es 13:45

For through that country there was a great way to go, namely, of a year and a half: and the same region is called Arsareth.
